Participant Personal Equipment List

Only the official uniform and parts are acceptable. Be prepared for an overnight hike as well as living in camp for 1 week.

Required:

- Uniform Shirt (2 recommended)
- Uniform Shorts (2 recommended)
- Uniform Stockings (3 pairs)
- Official Belt and Buckle
- Boy Scout Cap or Hat (optional)
- Plate, bowl, & cup**
- Knife, fork & spoon**
- Shoes, suitable for hiking
- Changes of shoes, as desired
- Rain gear, rain coat or poncho
- Sweatshirt, jacket or sweater
- Underwear (5 pairs minimum)
- Handkerchiefs (as needed) or tissue
- Pajamas or sweat suit
- Changes of clothes, as needed for 1 week
- Towels (2)
- Washcloths (2)
- Toothbrush & toothpaste
- Hand soap & container
- Shampoo
- Deodorant

Insect repellent

- Required or prescribed medication
(To be presented to Medical officer at Check-In)
- Comb or hair brush
- Backpack and backpack cover
or one trash bag
- Lightweight tent
(suitable for overnight hike)
- Canteen
- Ground cover
- Sleeping bag or blankets
- Foam pad or air mattress
- Flashlight
- Extra batteries & bulbs for flashlight
- Personal first aid kit
- Ball point pens and/or pencils
- Pocket knife (No Sheath Knives)
- Work Gloves
- Boy Scout Handbook*
- Junior Leader Handbook*
- Compass (official preferred)

- Sharpening stone
- Watch
- Sunglasses

NOTE: All participants need to arrive at camp in **complete** Scout uniform. Backpacks will be required for getting gear from the jumping-off place to the patrol campsite. Candidates will not be allowed to use suitcases, footlockers, or trunks at the campsite. All normal patrol equipment will be issued. Also, before coming, be sure that all badges and insignia are properly placed on the uniform.
