

# 2000 White Stag Woods and Water

## Participant Personal Equipment List

Only the official uniform and parts are acceptable. Be prepared for 5 nights on the trail, as well as living in camp for 1 week. All gear must be brought to the June 3 Shakedown meeting at Camp Kikthawenund. You will be checked for canoeing and backpacking abilities. Minimum gear items are bolded. Gear should be packed in ZipLock Bags. A hiking stave and a section of rope will be given to each participant.

  - Light weight shoes for campsite**  
Swim suit
  - Rain gear, raincoat or poncho**
  - Backpack and backpack cover**
  - Or Two-6mil 45 gal trash bag**
  - Lightweight tent (can share, & Suitable for Backpacking)**
  - Canteen/water bottles**
  - Ground cover**
  - Sleeping bag**
  - Foam pad or air mattress**
  - Flashlight w/ Extra batteries**
  - Pack and tent repair kit (1/patrol)**

### Optional:

- Sharpening stone
- Watch
- Sunglasses
- Lip Balm
- Sunscreen
- Camera and film

- Personal first aid kit**
  - Ball point pens and/or pencils
  - Pocket knife (No Sheath Knives)
  - Work Gloves
  - Insect repellent
- Required or prescribed medication**  
(In zip lock bag with name and directions)
- Jacket or sweater (wool or PP)**
- Underwear**
  - Handkerchiefs /bandannas
  - Sleepwear
- Changes of clothes**
  - Additional personal gear as needed
- Personal Hygiene items
  - Towels & wash cloth (2)
  - Toothbrush & toothpaste
  - Hand soap & container
  - Shampoo
  - Deodorant
  - Comb or hairbrush
- Boy Scout Handbook* (2/patrol)
- Junior Leader Handbook* (2/patrol)
- Compass (official preferred)
- Long sleeved shirt(s)

- Sewing kit
- Pillow/case
- Moccasins or slippers
- Personal Scouting equipment
- Stationary & stamps
- Fieldbook*, No. 33200 (1/patrol)
- Religious or prayer books

**NOTE:** All participants need to arrive at camp in **complete** Scout uniform. Backpacks are required. Place all smellables in a draw sting stuff bag with your name on it for placing in Bear bag. Candidates will not be allowed to use suitcases, footlockers, or trunks at the campsite. All normal patrol equipment will be issued. Also, before coming, be sure that all badges and insignia are properly placed on the uniform.
