I have spent a little time reviewing the staff manual. To provide staff with all material for days 1-7 will require copying 170 pages. I will also suggest we include the following pages from the appendix: 243-264, 287-301, 314-321, 325-335, and 341. This is an additional 57 pages. Please review the appendix and advise if you have any additions or deletions. This would bring the total to 229 pages.

I have checked a few places and can get all the copies we need at 2 cents a page. Last year the Scout office did not charge us, but can we be sure of what they will do this year? Anyway, 229 pages at .02 = \$4.58 times 50 copies = \$229.00. I believe we are only budgeted \$5.00 per copy and would still need to provide a three ring binder. Additionally this paper would not be three hole punched and we would need to provide staff with punches and time to do so.
