- I. **Tenting and Bedding with Tommy and Sly** (McConnell, Dilley, Gorsuch)
  - A. TAKE NOTES
  - B. need 2 tents and gear
  
- II. **Dining Area and Kitchen with Esther Posthole** (Bowen, Kastner, Hammes)
  - A. TAKE NOTES
  - B. proper set up of patrol box
    - 1. patrol kitchen
    - 2. wood tools box
  - C. properly set up dining fly
  - D. proper food storage
  - E. return ALL perishables to quartermasters
  - F. duty roster
  - G. name tags, including for guests
  - H. centerpiece
  
- III. **Fire Building and Cooking** (Kasper, Rines, Dennis)
  - A. TAKE NOTES
  - B. NO UNATTENDED FIRES -- EVER
  - C. explain Dakota hole
    - 1. NO COOKING
    - 2. only for heating water
  - D. proper set up of Sheepherder stoves
    - 1. legs
    - 2. charcoal tray
    - 3. grills
  - E. only use fire starters
    - 1. no paper
    - 2. will be provided with each meal
  
- IV. **Sanitation with Nasty Elmo** (Miller, Huehls, Zerbe)
  - A. TAKE NOTES
  - B. always use fresh water
  - C. WASH - RINSE - SANITIZE
  - D. proper use of bleach
  - E. proper way to dry dishes
  - F. how to dispose of dish water
  - G. NO grease pits
  - H. Garbage cans
    - 1. off ground
    - 2. empty to dumpster DAILY

- I. Latrine cleaned daily
  - 1. post rotation on duty roster
- J. Showers
  - 1. times
    - a) after breakfast
    - b) after evening program and before lights out
  - 2. Each person should leave area clean
  - 3. Service patrol responsible for daily cleaning
- V. **Food Quartermaster** (Nix, Horan, Funk)
  - A. TAKE NOTES
  - B. Food pick up times
    - 1. need to be responsible
  - C. how items will be provided
    - 1. how to make special requests
  - D. EVERYTHING is returned to Quartermasters
  - E. MENUS-read twice, prepare once
  - F. 3-4 guests for every meal
  - G. ALL MEALS MUST BE SERVED ON TIME
    - 1. say a grace before meals (a Scout is reverent)
  - H. Everything provided needs to be served
    - 1. serve all at one time
    - 2. serve family style -- NO BUFFETS
- VI. **Equipment Quartermaster** (Thomas, Taylor, Reece)
  - A. TAKE NOTES
  - B. Mrs. McConnell will need 5 minutes for First Aid
  - C. Explain what has been provided in each patrol site
    - 1. give a written inventory to one patrol member
  - D. explain patrol is responsible for care and cleanliness of all equipment
  - E. explain how to get extra or special needs
  - F. Demonstrate Ax Yard
  - G. Note when and where trading post will be located
