

DAILY PATROL EVALUATION

Explanation Sheet

Evaluation Area

Communications - Is the Patrol Leader passing on information from the Patrol Leader's Council to all members of this patrol? Are the members putting this information in their notebooks? Do they have the information when they become Patrol Leader? Do all Patrol members know the daily program schedule?

Use of Resources - Is the Patrol Leader aware of the capabilities of members of the Patrol? Does he use these resources effectively to accomplish tasks? Are resources within the Patrol used to teach others? Is the Patrol Leader resourceful enough to go outside his Patrol for resources when needed?

Sense of Belonging - Is it "our" Patrol as far as all members are concerned or have some just not joined?

Planning and Evaluating - Are adequate plans made prior to participation in Patrol and Troop activities? Are all Patrol members aware of the plans? Were adequate plans made? Are activities evaluated upon completion to improve future performance?

Group Decision Making - Is the Patrol Leader "running" the Patrol, making all the decisions and giving the orders, or is he sharing the problems or hurdles with the group and giving them a voice in the action to be taken?

On Time For Meetings - Do all members of the Patrol arrive on time for meetings? Does the Patrol Leader coordinate the efforts of his/her Patrol so that they stay on track toward meeting their task objectives on time? Does the Patrol begin their meetings on time?

Patrol Site Evaluation - Is the Patrol site neat and orderly? Is it laid out for optimum convenience and utility? Does the site make good use of the terrain? Are good health and safety standards maintained?

Personal Inspection - Are Patrol members clean and in proper uniform? Do they set a good example?

Meal Evaluation - Are meal preparations complete so that all Patrol members can begin eating on schedule? Has food been prepared and cooked properly?

Participation and Performance - Does the Patrol arrive properly for scheduled activities? Is the Patrol prepared when assigned program responsibilities? Does the Patrol accomplish tasks with a quality effort?
